



## JFK Admirals Club and Flagship Lounge Facilities

### Overview of Admirals Club, Concourse C

The first Admirals Club at John F. Kennedy International Airport (then called Idlewild) opened July 15, 1960. That was 21 years after American Airlines opened the industry's first VIP lounge at LaGuardia Airport in New York (1939). That first Idlewild Admirals Club was replaced by an impressive new club located on Concourse C in 2005. The new club is located in the remote concourse of the new terminal across from Gate 42 and convenient to a variety of new shops and the main concession area.

The new JFK Admirals Club brings a slice of the Big Apple experience to travelers right in the middle of one of the world's busiest airports. Dozens of vintage photographs on the walls depict everything from the excavation of the Brooklyn Battery Tunnel and construction workers atop huge skyscrapers to historic sports venues such as Yankee Stadium, Ebbets Field and the Polo Grounds.

An impressive wall of windows overlooks the airport and American's gates and planes. Small sculptures of children playing with gliders and paper airplanes dot the facility. And even the floor in the three private shower areas features imbedded replicas of New York City manhole covers with the familiar "Manhattan DPW" insignia.

The Admirals Club has become synonymous with productivity, comfort and convenience at major airports throughout the United States, Canada, the Caribbean, Europe, Asia and Latin America. The new JFK Admirals Club boasts 11,300 square feet with seating capacity of 165. A Cyber Café provides four personal computers with high-speed Internet access, in addition to T-Mobile Wi-Fi hotspots throughout for subscribers. Power outlets on all tables and under bench seating are accessible and plentiful, making it easy for members to be productive. The multi-functional Business Center includes 12 private workstations, 6 with personal computers and printers, a copier, and a flat fee fax service. Members also enjoy free local phone calls.

The Children's Room sports two personal computers and a flat-panel television, featuring age appropriate programming like Nickelodeon and the Cartoon Network. There also are two television lounges featuring additional flat-panel televisions with DIRECTV® service. Members and their guests can relax in a welcoming atmosphere and take advantage of complimentary coffee, tea, soft drinks, juices and snacks. Daily newspapers including The New York Times, The Wall Street Journal, USA Today, New York Post, Daily News and select magazines also are complimentary.

The spa-like shower facilities include three private shower and bathroom combinations, complete with towels, shampoo and body gels, blow-dryers, as well as shower caps and razors upon request.

The Admirals Club offers the best in premium services to members, including personal assistance with reservations, seat selection and upgrades, as well as boarding passes. The club also is staffed with personnel fluent in Spanish, French and Portuguese to assist international travelers. A VIP room is located on the Main Concourse across from Gate 40 and close to the new club.

### **Overview of Admirals Club and Flagship Lounge, Concourse B**

"New York Elegance" best describes the new Admirals Club and Flagship Lounge at John F. Kennedy International Airport. With a choice of environments in which to work or relax, members and visitors alike will appreciate the variety of amenities and services available at American Airlines newest Admirals Club and Flagship Lounge.

From the welcoming reception area a serpentine art gallery of exquisite art available on consignment leads to the lounge areas beyond. Other art in the lounges is from American's collection.

The contemporary design is bright, airy and modern, yet comfortable, built around a timeless, neutral color scheme with marble and limestone flooring, sycamore paneling and metallic finished tiles; it is accented with colorful artwork and flat screen TV's to provide the day's news, weather, sports and other events. Spacious lounges with expansive exterior views of nearby aircraft activities and the New York City Skyline in the distance are flanked by more intimate TV lounges, cocktail and bistro areas.

Both lounges feature a variety of seating choices for individual preferences and comfort. Seating arrangements have been planned to provide an extra margin of personal space with convenient side tables and electrical outlets for laptops and charging of other personal electronics. There is an enclosed Children's Room offering computers loaded with educational software and television programming geared for kids. The Club and Flagship Lounge share two conference rooms equipped with flat screen TV's and plug and play audio visual capabilities (available for a fee), and a cluster of seven private shower suites.

For business or personal connectivity, the Club and Flagship Lounge will each offer focus Business Center areas both with private carrels and "touch down" work counters along the windows with a view to the outside world. Included is a new, more robust complement of HP PC's, 11 in work carrels and 4 more located on walk up Cyber Cafes. Complimentary copiers as well as printing capabilities will be available for anyone using the PC's, or connected on their own laptops to the lounge's WiFi. In addition to more data connection options, there will also be electrical power outlets available from most chairs in the lounge area.

The club has a staffed bar with an expanded offering of food choices, while the Flagship Lounge offers a serve-yourself complimentary food and beverage area complete with a wide selection of wines, liquors and other beverages as well as expanded food offerings including hot and cold selections.

In all, this new Admirals Club and Flagship Lounge facility will provide a new level of service to members and guests at American's new terminal at JFK, with a focus on connectivity and comfort.
