## First look at American Airlines New 777-300ER Service

In December 2012, American Airlines will operate the new state-of-the-art Boeing 777-300ER on flights between Dallas/Fort Worth and Sao Paulo, and in January 2013 on select flights to London Heathrow. American was the first U.S. airline to order this aircraft and will be the first to take delivery. American is scheduled to take delivery of 10 Boeing 777-300ERs in 2012 through 2013.



The new aircraft is designed to enhance the customer experience and includes fully lie-flat First and Business Class seats, plus seating plans that will allow American to offer a premium product in Economy Class and Wi-Fi capability to keep customers connected while travelling internationally.



Arranged in a three-class cabin configuration, customers will be welcomed into the aircraft by unique mood lighting. First Class will offer new Flagship Suite seats offering a variety of pleasing comfort features. Business Class will also be outfitted with fully lie-flat seats – all with aisle access and desired comfort



amenities. Seats throughout Economy Class will have a higher recline pivot, providing increased knee room and more personal space.
